TOURNAMENT RULES

1. AVERAGE:

ALL BOWLERS WILL USE THEIR HIGHEST USBC AVERAGE FOR THE 2016-2017 SEASON UNLESS THEIR 2017-2018 AVERAGE IS 10 PINS OR MORE HIGHER AT THE TIME OF THE TOURNAMENT. BOWLERS MUST HAVE AN ESTABLISHED AVG. FOR 2017-2018 SEASON BASED ON MINIMUM 21 GAMES. RULE 319A, ITEM 1 IN EFFECT.

2. HANDICAP:

ALL BOWLERS HANDICAPS WILL BE BASED ON 90% OF 220. THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO ALL NON-ESTABLISHED BOWLERS ON BEHALF OF THE CHARITY ONLY. THOSE WITH NON-ESTABLISHED AVERAGES WILL BOWL SCRATCH.

3. USBC RULES WILL PREVAIL.

THE DECISION OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR IN ALL INTERPRETATIONS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE FINAL. UNLESS AN APPEAL IS MADE WITHIN 10 DAYS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE USBC RULES. THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY ENTRY. THIS TOURNAMENT IS USBC CERTIFIED.

4. PINSETTERS:

IF AUTOMATIC PINSETTERS OR TELESCOPERS HAVE A MAJOR BREAKDOWN THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MOVE BOWLERS TO OTHER LANES AND THE MATCH WILL CONTINUE FROM THE SAME POINT. THIS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. IF TELESCOPERS SHOULD FAIL AND SCORES OF A MATCH ARE LOST, BOTH TEAMS WILL RE-PLAY THEIR GAME STARTING AT THE FIRST FRAME OF THAT GAME.

5. SUBSTITUTIONS:

SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED. IF A SUBSTITUTION OCCURS DURING A GAME, THE HANDICAP OF THE SUBSTITUTE WILL BE USED.

6. RE-ENTRY

A BOWLER MAY COMPETE WITH AS MANY TEAMS AS DESIRED; TEAMS MAY ENTER MORE THAN ONCE, BUT NO MORE THAN THREE (3) BOWLERS ON THE SAME TEAM CAN PLACE MORE THAN ONCE IN THE PRIZE STANDINGS. USBC RULE 317 IN EFFECT.

7. RE-RATING/ADJUSTING AVERAGES:

ANY BOWLER WHO HAS BEEN RE-RATED OR HAD AN AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT DURING ANY TOURNAMENT BY THE COMMITTEE MUST REPORT THIS AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. USBC RULE 319C AND E IN EFFECT.

8. BOWLING ORDER:

THE ORDER IN WHICH BOWLERS ARE LISTED ON THE ENTRY FORM WILL BE THE OFFICIAL BOWLING ORDER.

9. RESPONSIBILITY:

IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE BOWLER TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF HIS OR HER AVERAGE, ADDRESS, ETC. AS IT APPEARS ON THE ENTRY FORM. FAILURE TO CORRECTLY REPORT INFORMATION MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

NEW REQUIREMENT

ALL BOWLERS MUST HAVE THEIR
CURRENT USBC MEMBERSHIP
CARDS AT REGISTRATION

10. PREVIOUS PRIZE MONEY:

THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE WON A MINIMUM OF \$300 WITHIN THE LAST 24 MONTHS IN ANY TOURNAMENT MUST REPORT THIS TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. THIS MAY RESULT IN RE-RATING OF THE BOWLER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.

11. PARTICIPATION/AGE RESTRICTIONS:

ALL GRADE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO HAVE NOT ATTAINED THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE WRITTEN CONSENT OF A PARENT OR GUARDIAN BEFORE BOWLING.

12. TERMINATION:

PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE TOURNAMENT BROUGHT ABOUT BY WAR, NATIONAL EMERGENCY OR EMERGENCY CAUSES RELATING TO FIRES, STRIKES, TORNADOS, ETC. SHALL CAUSE FOREGOING PRIZE SCHEDULE TO BE PRORATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NUMBER OF ENTRANTS WHO HAD BOWLED AT THE TIME OF TERMINATION.

13. BOWLING EQUIPMENT:

THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXAMINE ALL EQUIPMENT IN USE BY THE BOWLER. IF NEEDED THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR MAY CHECK THE DRILLING AND WEIGHT OF ALL BALLS BEING USED BY A PARTICIPANT.

14. PRIZE FUND:

THE PRIZE FUND WILL BE BASED ON A MINIMUM OF 160 TEAMS. THE PRIZE RATIO WILL BE 1:10. ALL PRIZE FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100%.

15. TEAM REGISTRATION:

ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE FILLED OUT TO COMPLETION. EACH REGISTRATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PAYMENT OF \$80.00 DUE BY THE PREVIOUS WEDNESDAY OF THE SQUAD. DUE TO LIMITED AVAILABILITY, REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. IF PAYING BY CHECK, PLEASE MAKE TO: BOULEVARD BOWL. MAIL ENTRIES TO: BOULEVARD BOWL, 1315 ERIE BLVD. SCHENECTADY NY 12305. ENTRIES ACCEPTED UNTIL APRIL 23RD. TEAM CAPTAINS MUST CHECK IN WITH TOURNAMENT MANAGER 1/2 HOUR BEFORE SQUAD.

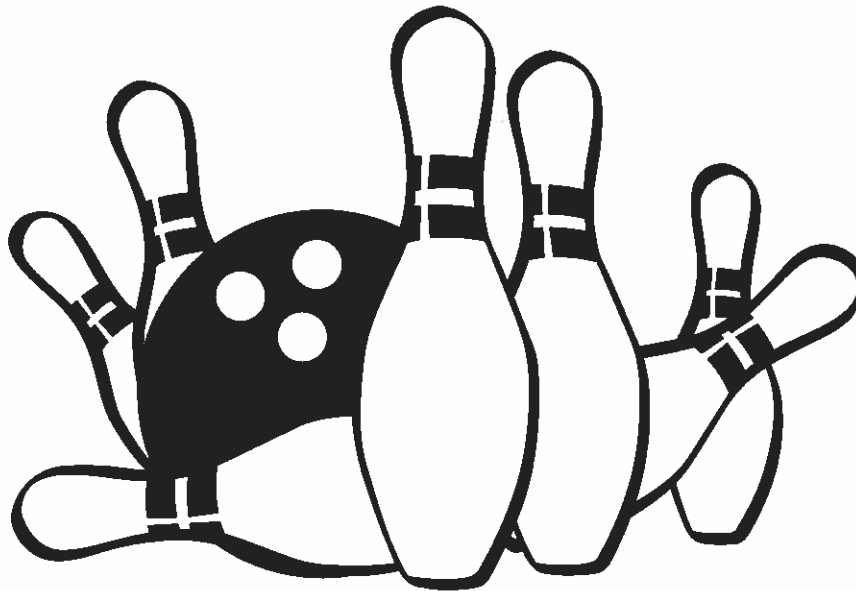
