Schenectady USBC OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

- The Schenectady USBC Open Championship Tournament is open to all bowlers who are sanctioned to bowl by USBC and observe the Rules and Regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Association membership dues shall apply: (Schenectady USBC Fee: \$ 5.00)
 - This Tournament will include three person teams.
 - The Tournament is handicapped, which will be figured on 90% of the difference between the bowler's entering average and 240. Bowlers that enter the tournament with an average over 240 will receive no handicap.
 - A bowler's entering average will be his/her highest verifiable 2021 2022 league average in any USBC league with a minimum of 42 games. If no 2021–2022 average, then the highest average from a 2020-2021 USBC sanctioned league may be used, with a minimum of 42 games. If no verifiable previous season average, then current season USBC sanctioned league average may be used with a minimum of 42 games. All others must bowl scratch. Please note: In accordance with USBC rule 319-A-3, a bowler who fails to use the proper average or make corrections prior to the completion of game one, shall be disqualified if the average reported is lower than the actual average.
- Multiple participation is permitted in the Team events. However, in the Team event, only two (2) persons who have bowled together on a Team can participate together on another team.
 Scores bowled in the Team Event will be used for the Singles Event however, bowlers may cash in Singles a maximum of three times but only once in the top five(5).
- Starting lanes will be assigned by the Tournament Director. The tournament committee will make all participant changes prior to the start of a squad. No changes will be allowed once a squad has begun, unless due to an injury. The tournament committee reserves the right to re-assign starting lanes to accommodate walk-ins or to effectively utilize lane usage.
- The tournament committee shall have the power to accept all substitutes offered by the team captain or his/her representative. If accepted, each substitute must bowl under their own name, be responsible for providing their entering average and must comply with Rule No. 1.
- 5. This tournament waives USBC Rule 319D. All individuals shall be familiar with Rule 319-a/3 and 319e that concerns reporting average.
